Discussion

1. IPEDS Proposed Changes

Zun shared the four major changes are proposed for the Outcome Measures (OM) form.

- a. Interest in a 4-year completion rate for a full-year cohort. Questions about whether this is fall and spring combined, or as two separate cohorts?
- b. Four Pell Grant sub-cohorts will be reported. Currently there are four groups: First Freshmen FT and PT and Transfers FT and PT.
- c. Add 4-year status after entry
- d. Add Institutional award status for these cohorts.

Full information was sent out in the IPEDS list serve, and in the email Cheryl sent out.

Changes to the ethnicity categories. Seems that the 'white' category may break down more. This is more than just IPEDS but also all government reporting.

2. Data Integrity/Data Governance

Betsy presented a small presentation on the work at BMCC to start a "Data Integrity Group" which has been working since January.
